- Sponsors, Board of Directors, ice rink and coaches were recognized and thanked

Membership Report (Natalia)

- LSC currently has 138 full members and 3 associate members.
- Confirmed the Aspire membership category will be added when needed with \$45 dues and 4 hour annual volunteer requirement.
- Membership renewals mid-May for the 2021-2022 membership year, with a June 25th deadline to avoid a late fee.

Treasurer's Report (Nancy)

- Nancy provided the Treasurer's Report
- The Club is in a solid financial position
- \$36,000 of this is in the Tomcyek Fund, designated solely for seminars/clinics
- Primary sources of income: dues, donations, fundraising, competitions
- Generally annual expenses for core operations are greater than annual income (\$4,000-\$9,000 range)
- In recent years we rely largely on periodic gains from USFS competitions we host, rather than continued fundraising that many organizations do.
- Results from our last 2 events were disappointing from a financial point of view, as both the 2020 EGL Regionals & Midwestern Sectionals Dance Challenge and 2020 Van Camp Competition, which was cancelled, resulted in significant losses.

- Our 2020-2021 fiscal year ends April 30th. Income is projected to be \$3,000 greater than expenses.
